California Senate Bill 1305 requires retail suppliers of electricity to report to consumers “accurate, reliable and simple to understand information on the sources of energy (fuel types, including renewable fuels) that are being used for electricity generation...” (Public Utilities Code Section 398.1 (b)). The program is administered by the California Energy Commission (CEC).
